

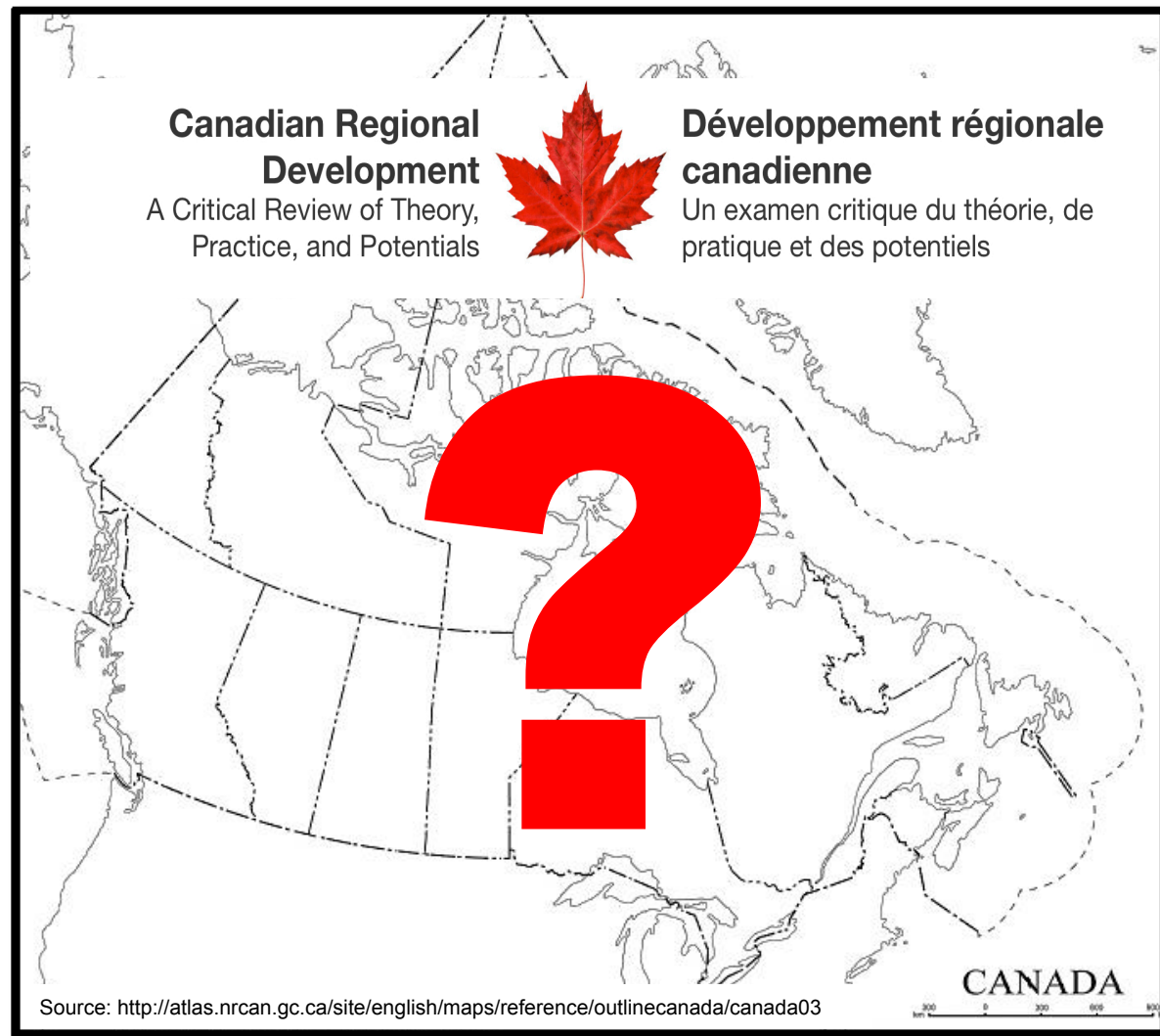

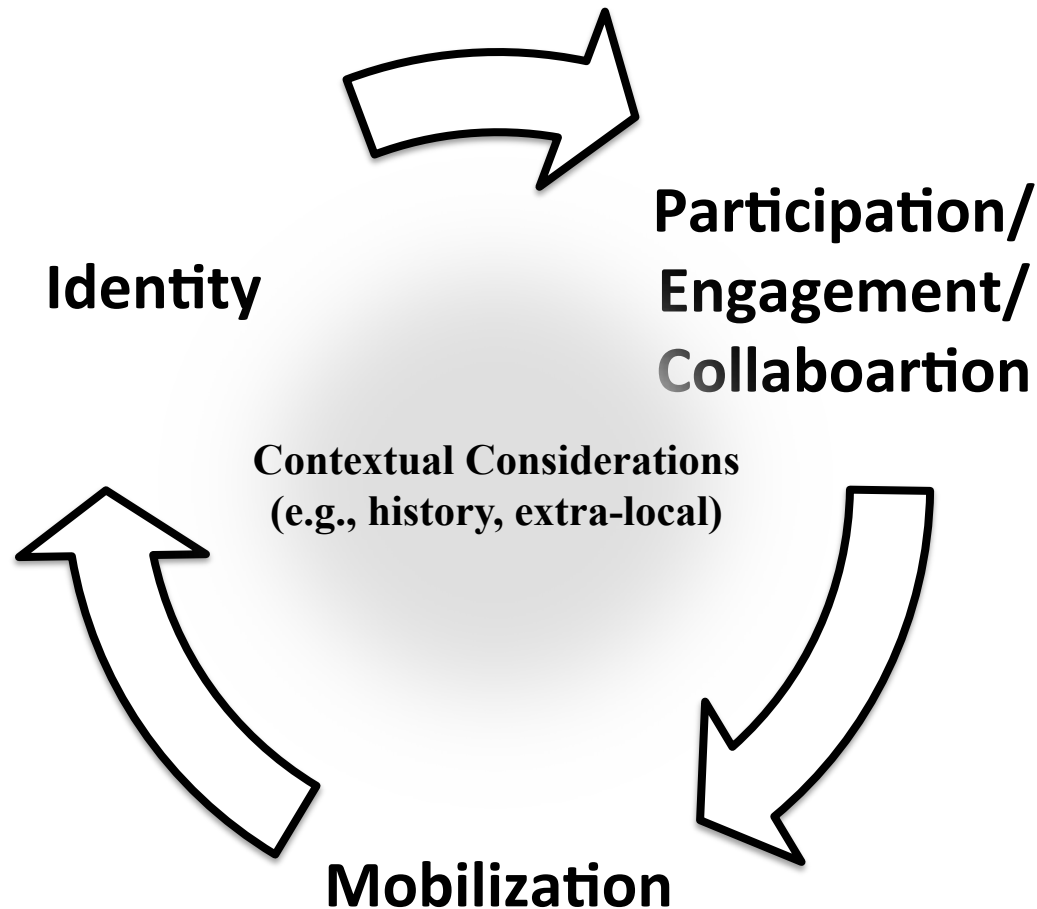

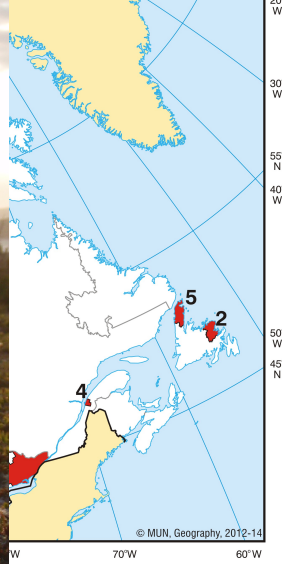

Weak Regional Identity



*“We hardly ever collaborate. We never have and it is hard as hell to collaborate on even a local level with anybody. It is hard to get three villages together to do anything. It is nearly impossible to get the district together to do anything. And only occasionally do the areas in the regions and different regional districts get together to do anything. **And when we do get together it is usually to fight something that somebody else is doing.**”*

*"I have often pondered the question of **whether the territory made sense**...I wonder if the MRC should not deal with the hinterlands only and the city could deal with themselves and the two could work together (in concert) with each other."*

Community vs. Region

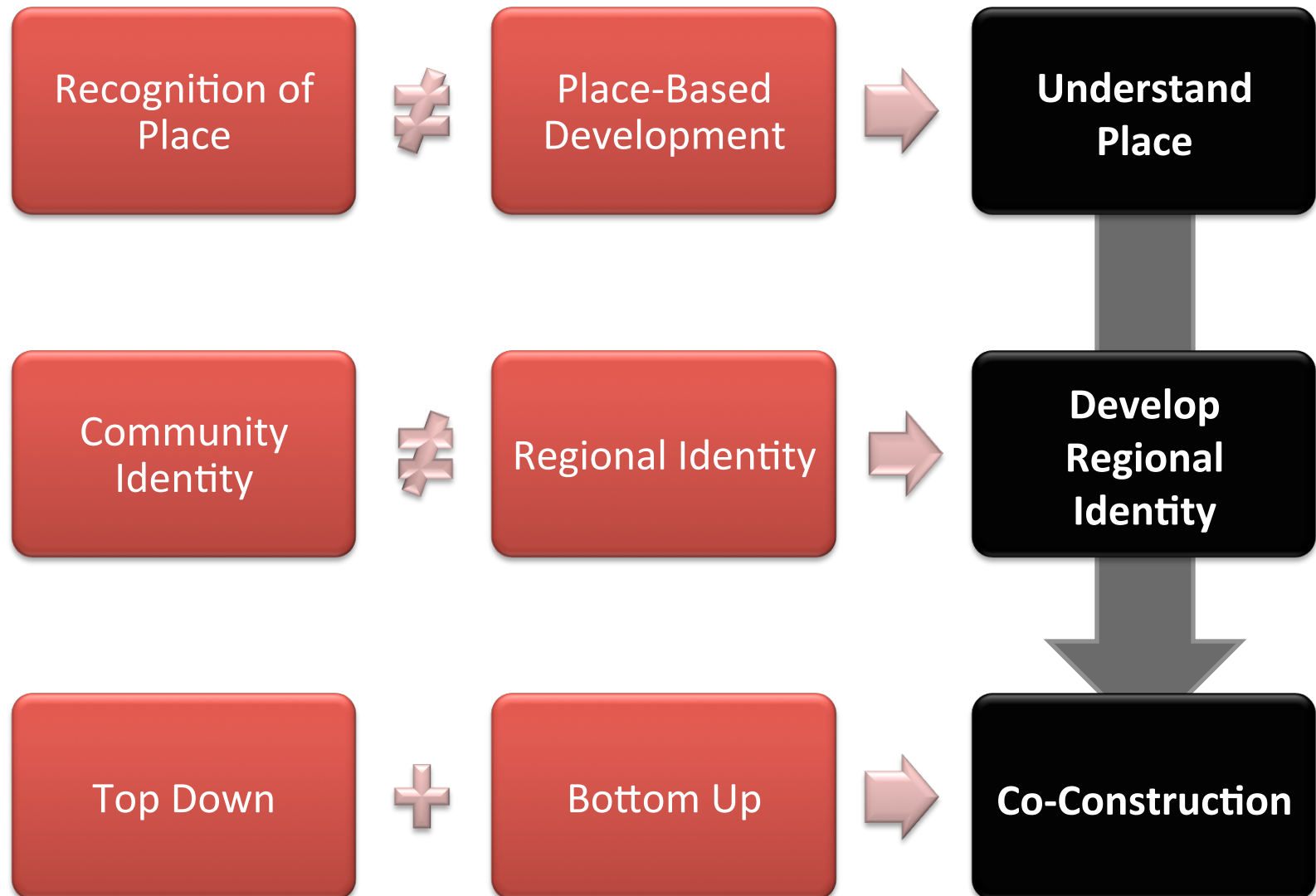
